The institution has its value based mechanism to obtain feedback on curriculum from its stakeholders such as Student, Faculty, Alumni and Employer. The importance of receiving feedback from stakeholders at a program level is recognized, with a primary focus on improving teaching and learning.

Feedback is essential in monitoring the student learning experience, which is an important factor in shaping both academic and personal development. Faculty feedback gives observations on the lacunae that they have observed in a few subjects and have also reported the modifications made during the course of the year. The inputs are also obtained from the Alumni for enriching the curriculum that helps to improvise the overall competency of the students for employability. Employers for the entire department have been looked at, which is inclusive of those who place students for internships as well as those who employ, both graduate and post graduate students.

We have collected online feedback from our under graduate final year students and post graduate students. An online feedback form on the curriculum is on college portal. The parameters on which the question designed included the difficulty level, the relevance, and practical application. The collective feedback of all the stakeholders was analyzed. This feedback is then conveyed to the Principal during curriculum review meetings for consideration. This helps in enriching the curriculum and introducing new changes. 
#### **4** Graphical Analysis of Students' Feedback Response















#### **♣** Graphical Analysis of Faculty Feedback Response















#### **♣** Graphical Analysis of Alumni Feedback Response
