


No Plastic Day: January 26, 2021

As plastic bags take around 100-500 years to decomposes, it creates land pollution as it is dumped in landfills and proves hazardous to the marine animal if gets washed into oceans. So, it becomes imperative to raise an alarm against the ill effects of single-use plastic bags. The SES-REC was constituted in August 2020, in response to the request made by the Maharma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education at the beliest of the Ministry of Education.		
Objectives:	To spread awareness about the hazards of plastic. To impart knowledge about the reduction and re-use of plastic. To understand the use of the alternatives of plastic. To contribute towards preserving the environment and reduction of plastic pollution.

Aimed at reducing the environmental degradation from improper disposal of used plastic bags, the No Plastic Bag Day program applies a "market" instrument to discourage consumers from using plastic bags to carry items purchased. In the program, participating stores do not give out plastic bags. Mr.V.S.Pawar, Program Officer, Ms Deepmala Desai, Program Officer of NSS, along with other faculty bave arranged this programme in the campus.





On the sixth day we have arranged grain cleanliness drive and two sessions for the students, on conservation of environment and employability. Indoor and outdoor activities were organized under employability.


