Describe two practices institutionalized as a result of IQAC initiatives within a maximum of 500 words

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) reviews the teaching learning process, structure and methodologies of operations and learning outcomes at periodic intervals. Accordingly two practices institutionalized as a result of IQAC initiatives are as follows.

Response:

1. Skill Enhancement Training Programme and Introduction of Career Oriented Certificate Courses

With an objective of overall development of students to enhance their skill sets and to make them employable, IQAC Cell emphasized to organize various training programmes. Accordingly a committee comprising three faculty members is constituted under Training and Placement Cell of the institute. The committee had organized skill enhancement training programs of two weeks for BE and MBA students on diversified topics such as Training Programme on IOT, Python for Data Science, Spoken English, Introduction to MATLAB and its application, Fearless Spoken English, Personality Development, Introduction to AUTOCAD etc. Due to such initiatives, student's skill sets and performance level have improved.

Similar to the conventional degree courses, the non-conventional degree courses also has the power to offer excellent job opportunities to students. Hence recognizing the importance of Career Oriented Courses and to provide the practical knowledge to students, IQAC proposed to start such courses in every department. Accordingly every department identified Job Oriented Courses suitable for students and framed the syllabus. The syllabus is submitted to University and approved. From year 2020-21, the institute started 11 courses such as Write and Speaks Communicative English, Nutrition and Diet Plan, Cosmetic Technology, Construction Techniques and Practices, Cyber Security, Energy Conservation and Management, Industrial Automation and Robotics, Advanced C, Product Design and Entrepreneurship, Retail Management, Quantitative Aptitude and Logical Reasoning etc. These courses include two theories and one practical subject based on current trends. Due to such courses, students got practical knowledge and their skill sets has increased.

2. Digital Education

Digital Education is a technique or method of learning which involves technology and digital devices. This is a new and broad technical sphere which helps any student to attain knowledge and gain information from any corner across the country. It is believed that Digital Education in India is the future of education and learning. Digital education is providing both teachers and students new opportunities to teach and learn thereby ensuring greater participation in the overall learning process. It also helps in enhancing technological skills of students. COVID-19 pandemic had briefly disrupted the education system in India. Since the 1st lockdown in March 2020, the Institute and IQAC focused on online delivery of lectures. All the faculty members and students quickly adapted the online delivery through Zoom, MSTeams and Cisco Webex etc.

In addition to this, institute has 38 class rooms and 03 Seminar Halls with ICT enabled facilities. For effective teaching and learning in each department one class room is provided with sophisticated ICT enabled facilities such as Wall-mounted Interactive LCD Projector, Duplex Projection Screen, Wi-Fi Access Point, Multimedia Speakers, Modular Wall-mounted cabinet for CPU, Keyboard and Mouse, PPT Presenter, Head Phone with Mike, Webcam.
