

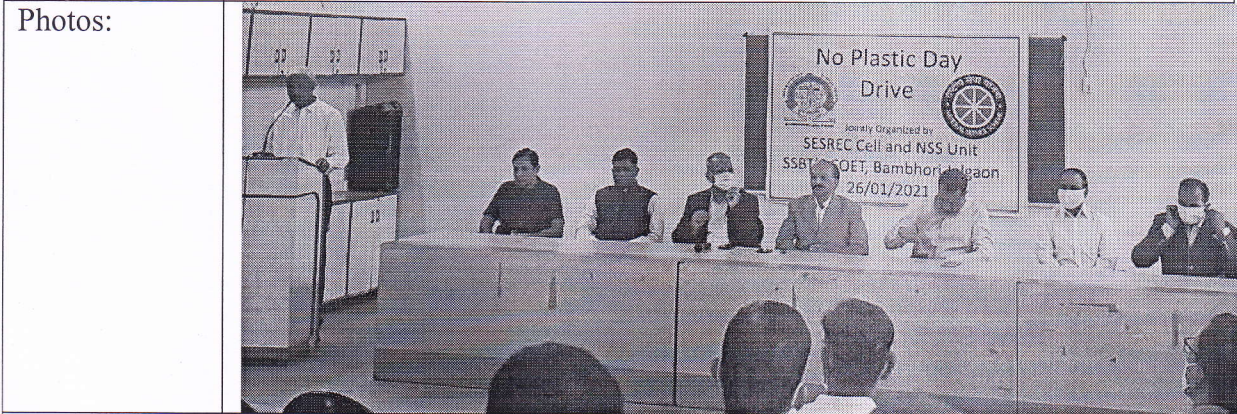

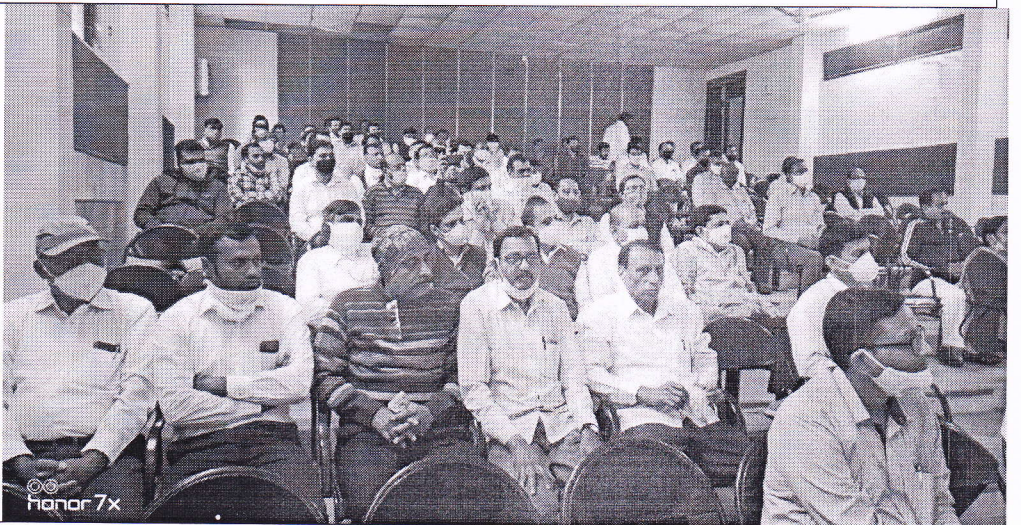
No Plastic Day: January 26, 2021

Date and Venue / Location:	January 26,2021 College Campus
Aim / Purpose:	The day is observed to raise awareness about the grave issues of plastic pollution and the serious threat that it poses to the natural environment ranging from land to marine life. As plastic bags take around 100-500 years to decomposes, it creates land pollution as it is dumped in landfills and proves hazardous to the marine animal if gets washed into oceans. So, it becomes imperative to raise an alarm against the ill effects of single-use plastic bags. The SES-REC was constituted in August 2020, in response to the request made by the Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education at the behest of the Ministry of Education.
Objectives:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To spread awareness about the hazards of plastic. 2. To impart knowledge about the reduction and re-use of plastic. 3. To understand the use of the alternatives of plastic. 4. To contribute towards preserving the environment and reduction of plastic pollution.
Participant's Profile:	Teaching and Nonteaching staff members and NSS Volunteers
Description about the Program:	No Plastic Bag Day program to discourage the use of plastic bags for carrying items purchased from shopping stores. In the country, most of them use plastic bags as carrier bags. However, their excessive use leads to a large amount of plastic waste. Plastic waste takes a long time to degrade and contributes to air, water and soil pollution. Aimed at reducing the environmental degradation from improper disposal of used plastic bags, the No Plastic Bag Day program applies a “market” instrument to discourage consumers from using plastic bags to carry items purchased. In the program, participating stores do not give out plastic bags. Mr.V.S.Pawar, Program Officer, Ms Deepmala Desai, Program Officer of NSS, along with other faculty have arranged this programme in the campus.
Feedback & Analysis:	-----
Outcomes:	The program helps society to <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Less plastic = less carbon dioxide. 2. Less recycling = less carbon dioxide.

3. Consuming less plastic saves animals.
4. Consuming less plastic can save humans.
5. Less plastic makes our water cleaner.
6. Less plastic makes our food safer.
7. Less plastic makes our air safer.

Recommendations: Such program should be arranged every year

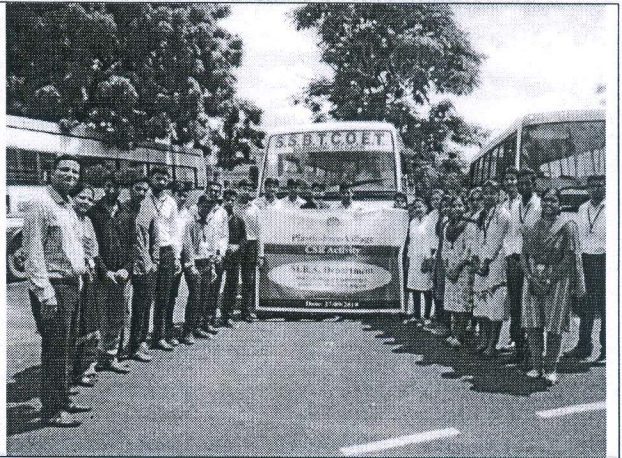



The camping area includes Kadholi Village. Apart from the local youth, 19 student-volunteers have been participated in the camp. This camp was headed by Shri. V. S.Pawar, and Ms Deepmala Desai, NSS Programme Officer. The NSS Special Camping Programme began with an inaugural function held at Kadholi. Sarpanch of the village preside over the function. The Sarpanch, who presided over the function, addressed the gathering. Mr. V.S.Pawar, Program Officer, reminded the aims and objectives of NSS. He asked the student volunteers to utilize this opportunity to serve villagers, and bring laurels to the college. He insisted the students to voluntarily render service to up-lift the weaker</p>

	<p>sections of the society He also asked them to gain knowledge and develop personality through active participation in all the NSS activities. Village authorities welcomed the NSS team into their village and assured them all sorts of co-operation needed in making the special camp a grand success. In the afternoon session of the first day, the NSS team planned to clean the premises of Zilla Parishad school, Kadholi. Four groups of NSS volunteers cleaned the playground and vacant areas in the school compound whereas the other groups focussed on cleaning the inside the classrooms. The volunteers cleaned the garbage which was strewn around the school campus. Later, the volunteers started a Procession in the streets of the villages to create awareness among the villagers about the ensuing special camp programme in the village for a period of one week. Lastly, volunteers discussed about the activities to be undertaken for the next day in the camp with NSS programme officer. Volunteers sang the NSS song and concluded the first day by NSS clapping.
