
No Plastic Day: January 26, 2021

So, it becomes imperative to raise an alarm against the ill effects of single-use plastic bags. The SES-REC was constituted in August 2020, in response to the request made by the Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education at the behest of the Ministry of Education.

Almed at reducing the environmental degradation from improper disposal of used plastic bags, the No Plastic Bag Day program applies a "market" instrument to discourage consumers from using plastic bags to carry items purchased. In the program, participating stores do not give out plastic bags. Mr.V.S.Pawar, Program Officer, Ms. Deepmala Desai, Program Officer of NSS, along with other faculty have arranged this programme in the campus.
