Aim / Purpose:

The NEP Orientation and Sensitization Programme (NEP-O&SP) is one of the flagship faculty development programmes conducted under the Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP) of the University Grants Commission (UGC). 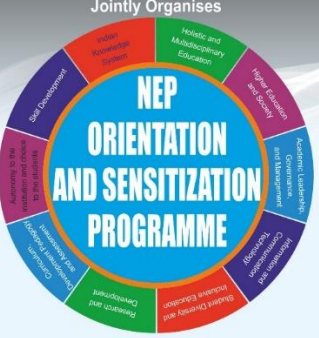
Incentive for Faculty :

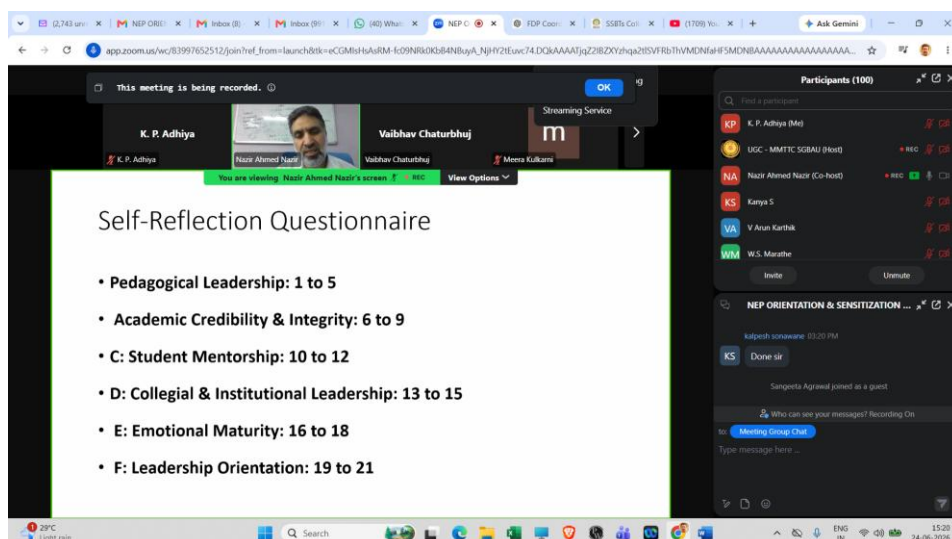
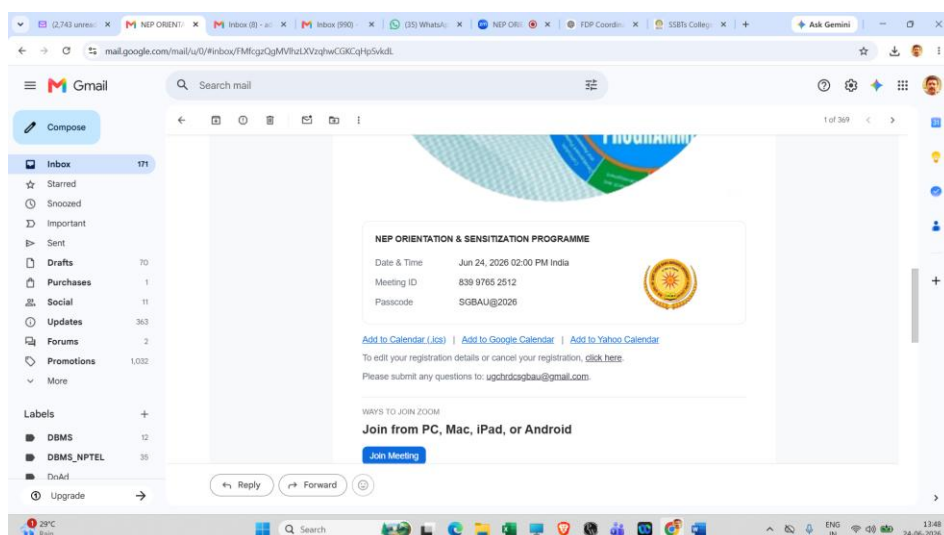

The average tomato yield per hectare in India is around 20-25 tons; The tomato yield per hectare in the Netherlands varies depending on the type of greenhouse used: Open field plantations: 50-75 tonnes per hectare; Low-tech greenhouses: 120 tonnes per hectare; Medium-technology greenhouses: 200-250 tonnes per hectare; High-tech greenhouses: 250-600 tonnes per hectare; The Netherlands' high tomato yields are due to the high proportion of high-tech greenhouses with hydroponic or substrate equipment.

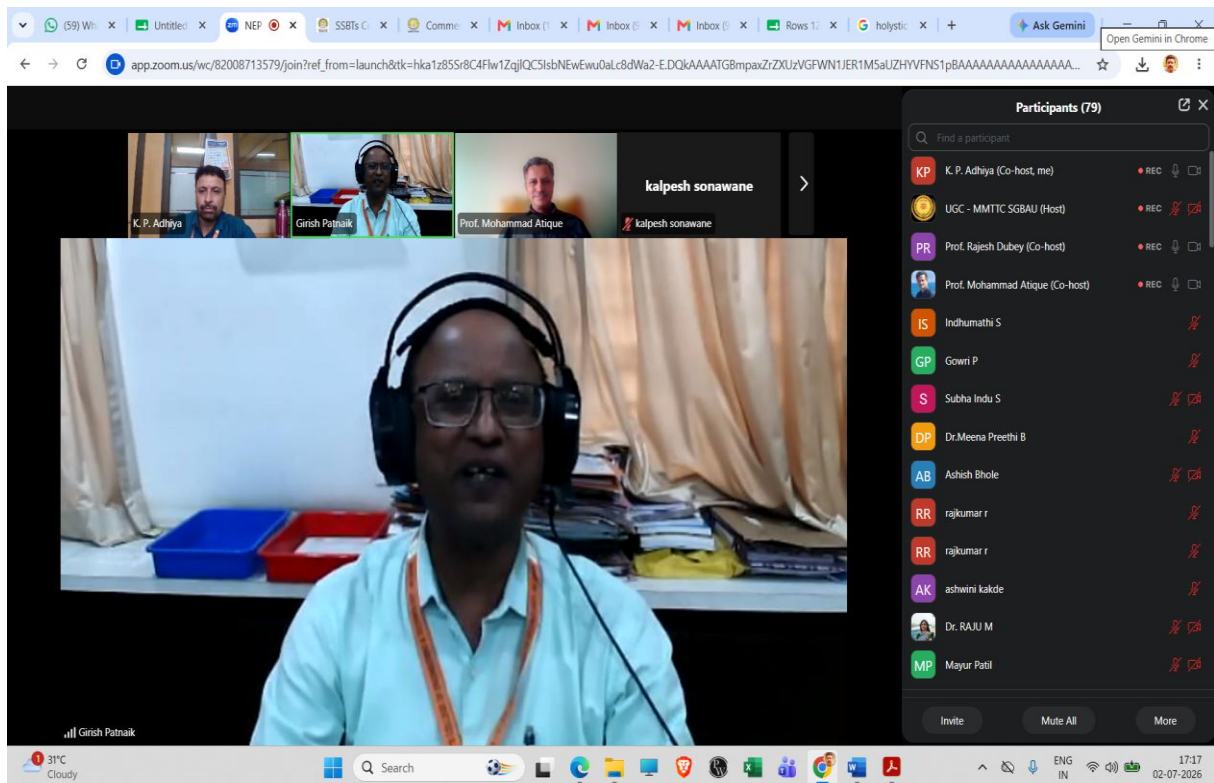

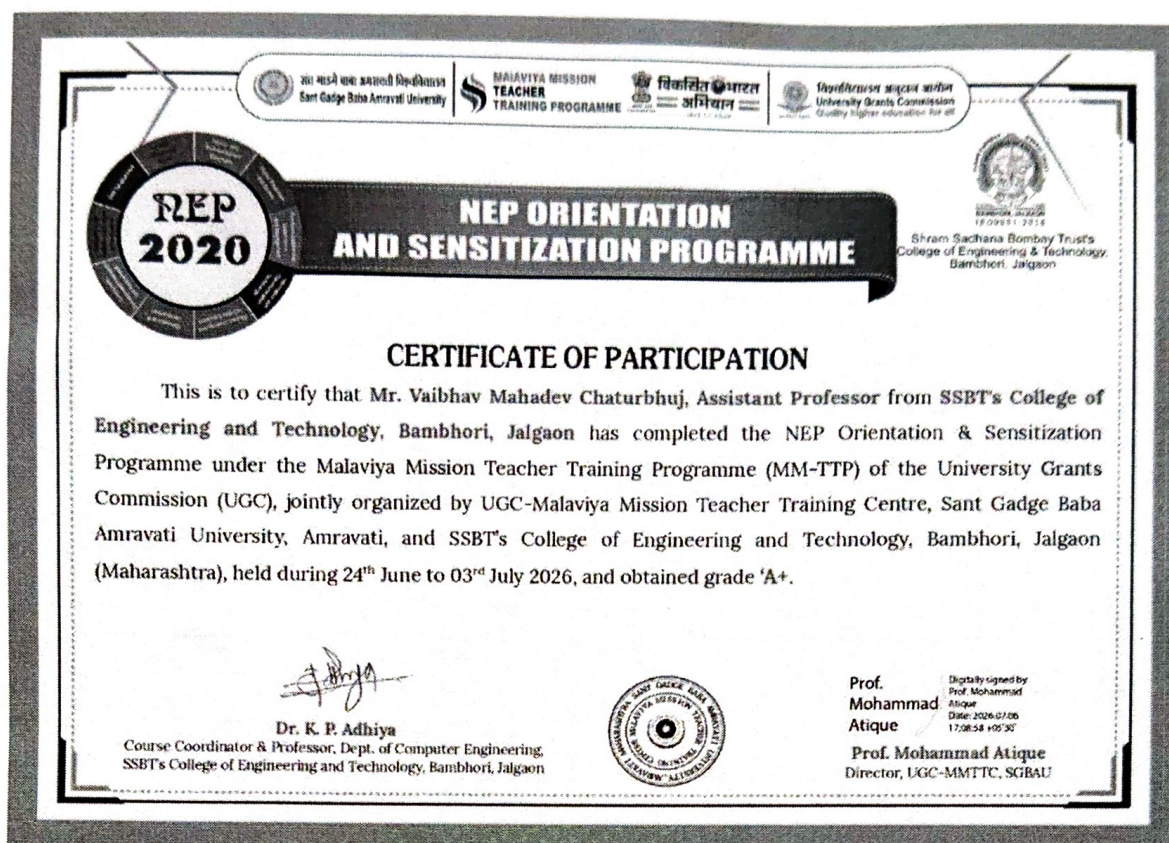
