2. Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA)

During departmental visit all the related documents were presented to the members. The committee members further observed all the central level facilities such as Computer center, Training & Placement cell, Central library, Open theatre, Playground, Yoga Hall, Gymnasium, Sports department, Cafeteria, Boys and Girls hostel, Workshop, Medical Facility and Administrative wings like Accounts Section, Scholarship Section, Establishment Section, Examination Section, Store etc and had interactions with the respective coordinators / section in charges. After inspection and verification of central level facilities along with departments, AAA Report covering the observations was prepared by the members.
