2. Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA)

The main objective of the academic and administrative audit is to review, assess and appraise the performance in domains of teaching-learning process, research, extra-curricular and administrative aspects pertaining to departments of the institution. The Committee had a formal interaction with the Principal, Directors, Head of Departments and Registrar. The committee members visited all departments in the first week of June 2020 and observed the infrastructural facilities of department such as classrooms, laboratories and interacted with the teaching staff and the technical staff to know the academic and administrative performance. During departmental visit all the related documents were presented to the members. The committee members further observed all the central level facilities such as Computer center, Training & Placement cell, Central library, Open theatre, Playground, Yoga Hall, Gymnasium, Sports department, Cafeteria, Boys and Girls hostel, Workshop, Medical Facility and Administrative wings like Accounts Section, Scholarship Section, Establishment Section, Examination Section, Store etc and had interactions with the respective coordinators / section in charges. After inspection and verification of central level facilities along with departments, AAA Report covering the observations was prepared by the members.
