A fee of INR 1600/4000/8000 has to be paid while submitting the patent application in the IPO, based on the type of applicant. A fee of INR 2500/6250/12500 has to be paid, based on the type of applicant, if you wish to have your patent application published by the IPO early.

Applications can also be made online through the available comprehensive online filing system. Therefore, legally, there is no bar on an individual to carry out the filing of his patent himself.

Patent applications must satisfy the following three criteria:

- 1. Novelty. This means that your invention must not have been made public not even by yourself before the date of the application.
- 2. Inventive step. This means that your product or process must be an inventive solution. ...
- 3. Industrial applicability.
