Session I is conducted by Er. Nivrutti Gajbhare, he discussed on Design Thinking is a process that involves stages of observation/interaction, empathy, problem formulation, solution deduction, testing, alteration and reiteration. Here, Critical Thinking is a part of every stage of the Design Thinking process.

Through critical thinking, we are encouraged to rigorously question ideas and assumptions, rather than accepting them without deeper reflection. In turn, design thinkers apply critical thinking to determine whether their ideas and findings represent a realistic picture of the user experience.

Engage the imagination to explore new possibilities. Formulate and articulate ideas. Recognize explicit and tacit assumptions and their consequences. Understand the concepts of design thinking approaches. Create design thinking teams and conduct design thinking sessions. Apply both critical thinking and design thinking in parallel to solve problems. Apply some design thinking concepts to their daily work.

Funding refers to the money required to start and run a business. It is a financial investment in a company for product development, manufacturing, expansion, sales and marketing, office spaces, and inventory. Many startups choose to not raise funding from third parties and are funded by their founders only (to prevent debts and equity dilution). However, most startups do raise funding, especially as they grow larger and scale their operations. This page shall be your virtual guide to Startup funding.

### **Stages of Startups and Source of Funding**

There are multiple sources of funding available for startups. However, the source of funding should typically match the stage of operations of the startup. Please note that raising funds from external sources is a time-consuming process and can easily take over 6 months to convert.

### Steps to Startup Fund Raising

The entrepreneur must be willing to put in the effort and have the patience that a successful fund-raising round requires. The fund-raising process can be broken down into the following steps

1. Assessing Need for Funding
2. Assessing Investment Readiness
3. Preparation of Pitchdeck
4. Investor Targeting
5. Due Diligence by Interested Investors
6. Term Sheet
