Outcomes: Students can Describe and discuss digital evidence.

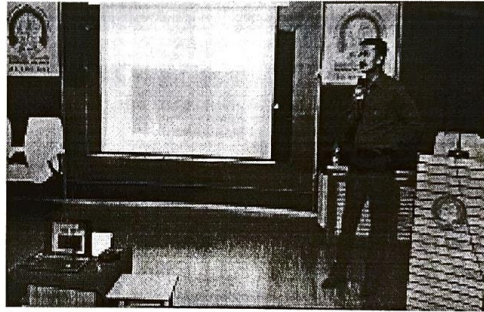
