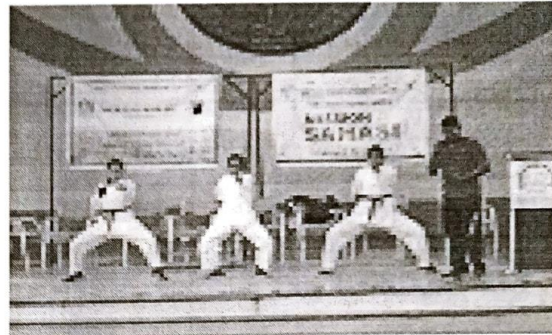
The ability to protect oneself physically from harm is a basic human right that should be accessible to everyone, including girls.. The world can be a dangerous place for girls and women, as they often experience violence. They're often perceived as easy targets – and while this may not be true, there is still a disproportionate amount of violence conducted against them. Many parents of girls and girls themselves are interested in learning how to protect themselves against violent situations, but they are often not sure where to turn. Workshops are a safe space where women of all ages develop mental and physical skills to defend themselves against attacks. We believe that every girl is strong and has to become aware of this internal power. programs help girls to develop their personality and grow into strong women. In this workshop some defence techniques are taught by trainer. Self defence techniques are followed by the girl students. Girls learned self defence

techniques. Practically they got knowledge and they are more confident about self defence. Total 90 students Attend the workshop.

Outcomes: One of the major impacts of this activity has been instilling a sense of fearlessness and enhancing mental strength among the girls. Students are beginning to feel more confident and secured having learnt techniques to defend themselves in times of crisis.
