



Participant's Profile:

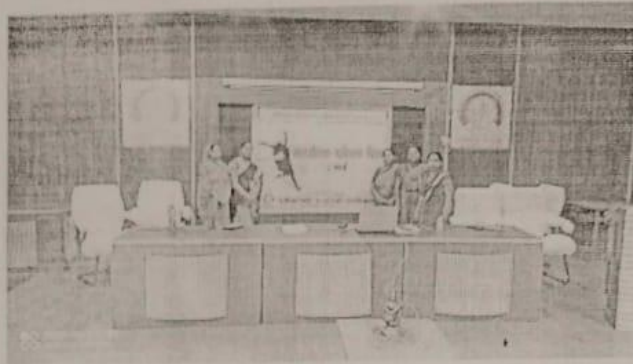
All the girls students from FE, SE, TE, BE, from all branches were present.

Speaker for programme was Ms. Pranita Subhash Wadodkar M.D.Aurved .The program was conducted online through Microsoft team. The link was shared to students one day before the scheduled program. Programme was started with warm welcome of Guest, by Nilima Ramteke , Assistant Professor Computer Engineering Department.

The speaker briefly explained about corona virus. She had given brief history of covid-19. When it is first spotted. What happened after that? How entire country facing with this virus. She also explained how to prevent this virus, what changes we can do to fight with virus. She explained what preventive measures we can follow and that are

1. Social distancing by maintaining a distance of at least 2 meters during interaction
2. Avoid touching face, mouth, nose or eyes unnecessarily & only after proper hand washing
3. Cover your mouth and nose during coughing or sneezing
4. Use mask properly if possible – must if you have symptoms of cough/sneezing

5. Please isolate yourself if you have symptoms like fever, cough or breathing problems and seek medical help at the earliest to avoid spreading the infection to others
6. Test yourself for COVID-19 if your doctor suggests, without delay
7. Practice healthy habits like a nutritious diet and exercise to boost your confidence and immunity.

She also explained at the social level, what one should follow

1. Encouraging the public to remain at home until lockdown ends
2. Avoid social gatherings
3. Cover your mouth during coughing/sneezing to stop its spread in the society
3. Please follow self-quarantine measures for a minimum of 14 days if you are directed to do so Please take precautions than indulging in a panic avoid hoarding of food and daily necessities, as it will create an artificial crisis
4. Help others during this period of crisis
5. Show your solidarity to COVID-19 positive patients and their families as tomorrow you may be in the same boat.

Feedback & Analysis: Students found the lecture really informative. Student knows about corona virus how to fight against this virus.

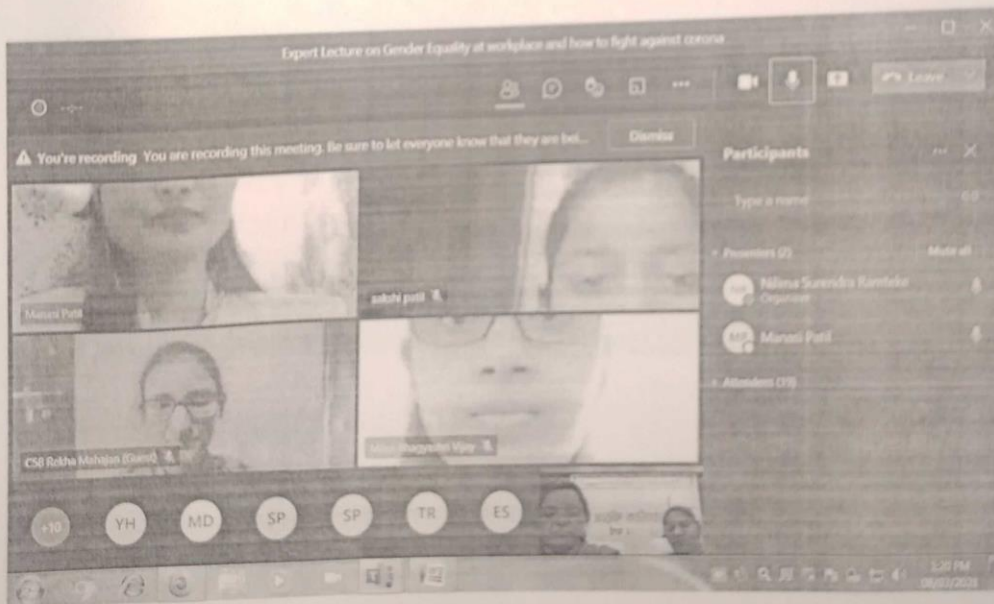
Outcomes:



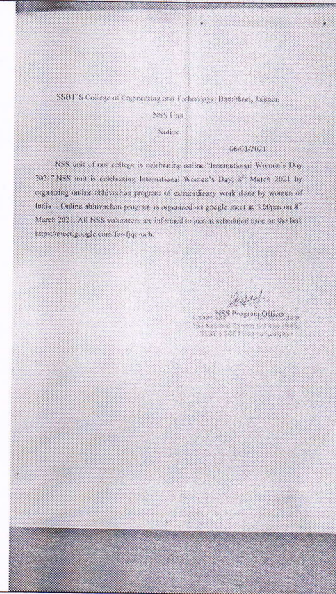
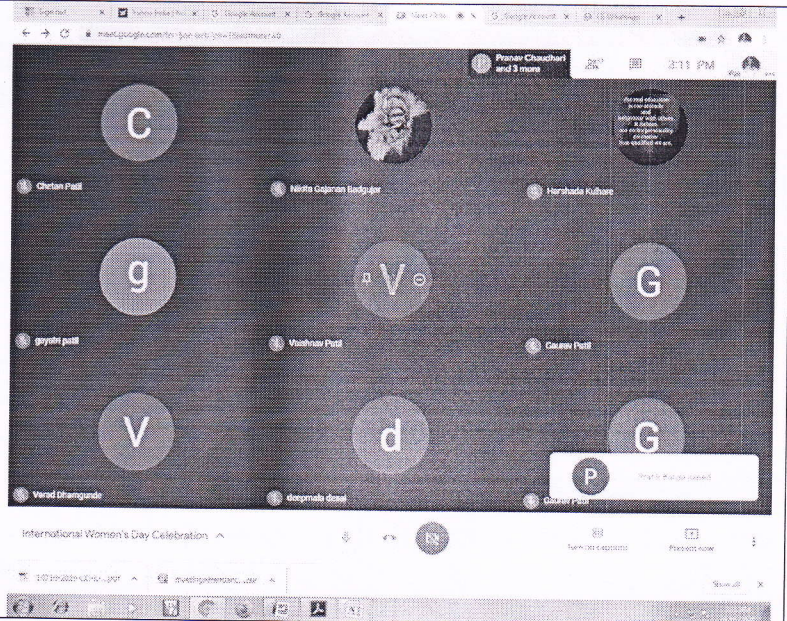
