A one-day workshop on "Counselling and Demonstration on Self-Defence" was organized for rural and urban girls' students at SSBT's College of Engineering and Technology, Bambhori, Jalgaon.

The workshop was inaugurated by Shri. Rajendra M. Janjale (District Swayamsiddha Instructor, Government of Maharashtra) and Ashwini Pratap Nikam (Female Police Constable, Karate Instructor, Jalgaon) as the instructors. On this occasion, the Dr. G.
